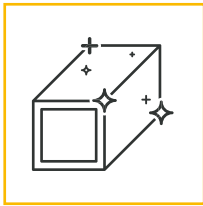


The Weather Tarp is a re-inforced industrial-strength PVC cover that protects your shipping container against the most formidable weather conditions.

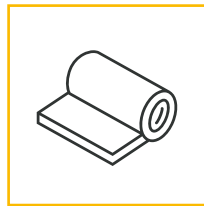


The Weather Tarp serves as a watertight shield, keeping the roof of your shipping container dry and preventing rust from forming. Additionally, the Weather Tarp offers the flexibility to incorporate a heat insulation layer (insulation material is not included with this product) between the tarp and your container. This feature allows you to better regulate the internal temperature of your container, allowing for a more conducive storage and work environment.

Extends the lifespan of your shipping container by preventing the roof from rusting



Allows for the placement of heat insulation panels on the roof of your container

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PRODUCT DETAILS

Included with the Weather Tarp cover are purpose-built steel clamps that fix to the four corner castings of your container and to the side ridges, ensuring waterproof reliability even under the most extreme wind and rain.

The UV coatings applied to the cover during production mean it holds up for years under the most unforgiving sunshine.

The Weather Tarp comes in three sizes, fitting 10-foot, 20-foot and 40-foot containers. The steel side ridge clamps fit on all container side configurations.

The Weather Tarp is guaranteed for 5 years.

**What sizes does the
Weather Tarp come in?**

We have 3 sizes of Weather Tarp covers.

All our covers are sized to match the measurements of commercial shipping containers. The Weather Tarp fits onto the roof of a 10-foot, 20-foot or 40-foot container. Please ensure you order the correct size to fit your container. For any queries on sizing, please contact our sales department for assistance.

**Is the Weather Tarp
waterproof?**

Yes, it is.

The Weather Tarp's primary function is to ensure that rainwater does not collect and rust away the top of your shipping container.

The cover is made from thick 610g industrial strength 100% waterproof PVC. We have designed the corner and edge clamping system to ensure water does not get under the cover, even in heavy wind and rain.

**Will the Weather Tarp cover
blow away in heavy wind?**

No, it will not.

Once the corner and side clamps are applied correctly to the cover, the Weather Tarp will not blow away in heavy wind as there is no means for the wind to get under the cover and lift it.



FAQ

How do I use the Weather Tarp to reduce the heat inside my container?

The Weather Tarp helps reduce the heat in your container in two ways. Firstly, having a PVC cover between your steel container roof and the blazing sun reduces the heating impact of the sun.

However, customers looking to considerably reduce the direct heat from the sun on their container should add a layer of heat insulation between the roof of their container and the Weather Tarp cover. This insulation typically comes in rolls and is inexpensive to order online. The insulation material does not need to be stuck down to the container as it is secured in place by the cover. The Weather Tarp is designed to allow for an insulation material thickness of up to 25mm.

In many cases, adding a layer of heat insulation under the cover of the Weather Tarp reduces the need to insulate the inside roof of your container, saving you money, hassle, and valuable internal headroom.

How is the Weather Tarp connected to a shipping container?

The cover of the Weather Tarp is secured to your shipping container using steel clamps that fix to the top of the four corner castings of your container. Additionally, the cover is secured to the side ridges of your shipping container using custom-designed steel clamps that are included with the cover.

Some commercial shipping containers will have a different shaped/sized ridge at the back of their container. If this is the case with your container, use the smaller-sized side ridge clamps included with the Weather Tarp. If the side ridge lip at the front of your container is too small to secure a clamp, you should use the adhesive strips included with the Weather Tarp.
